

Big projects in city's future

Mayor Martin Harder delivered his State of the City address Wednesday afternoon at the Winkler and District Chamber of Commerce's annual general meeting.

During his presentation, Harder talked at length about a number of major city projects wrapping up this year - the new fire hall, Bethel Heritage Park - as well as the many improvements and projects city council plans to pursue in the months and years ahead.

These include looking at resolving transportation issues along Hwys. 14 and 32 as they pass through the city, getting the new water treatment plant up and running, coming up with a plan for an addition to the Winkler Arena, and, looking really long-term, getting a major seniors housing project on 6th St. off the ground.
